- In 1996 expanded with the opening of St. Innocent Orphanage for teenage boys
- Over 10,000 volunteers have come to build homes for the poor and assist with projects at St. Innocent
- 180 homes built between 1988 and 2008
- St. Innocent Orphanage was named one of the top three institutions in the State of Baja California for 2001
